1. General

The release notes apply to Polycom Communicator software version 3.0.0.29. This Communicator software installation supports the installation on Microsoft® Windows Vista® /Windows 7® 32-bit and 64-bit operating systems. (For Windows XP® there is a different version of drivers available).

Polycom Communicator software is localized to support Chinese (Simplified), English (United States), French (France), German (Germany), Italian (Italy), Japanese (Japan), Portuguese (Brazil) and Spanish (Spain) languages. The installation provides an option to automatically start the Polycom Communicator on the restart of the PC in the minimize mode.

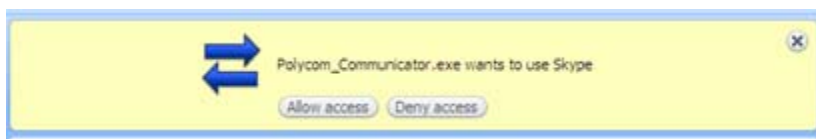
2. Software Installation and Set Up

This release does not support Windows XP.

To install the software, run (double-click) the installer.exe file after downloading it from the Polycom web site. Follow all instructions presented by the installer, including these important steps:

- The Polycom Communicator C100S must be plugged in to the USB port before or when prompted during the installation.
- The PC must be restarted after the installation to function properly

For a Windows Vista®/Windows 7® PC, the user will see the following prompt on the Skype™ user interface. The user has to click “Allow access” to grant permission to Polycom Communicator to use the Skype™ API. This step is mandatory for the proper functioning of the Communicator C100S device.



3. Software Features

When used with the Skype™ software application, the features listed in Table 1 are supported by the Communicator 3.0.0.29 for Skype™ software.

Table 1 Polycom Communicator Feature Matrix

<u>Polycom Communicator Features</u>
1. Volume Up – To increase speaker volume
2. Volume Down – To decrease speaker volume
3. Mute – To mute microphones
4. Launch – To launch Skype
5. Answer button – To answer incoming call
6. Answer button – To end an active call
7. Blinking Green LED – Alerting for an incoming call or while making an outgoing call
8. Solid Green LED – Call is in progress
9. Solid Red LED – Microphones are muted
10. Blinking Red LED – Call is on Hold
11. Polycom Communicator will wake up from Standby mode in case of incoming call
